Reviewed Conference Proceedings on CD.

Papers will be put into the programme and published in the conference proceedings only in the case of a positive response from the reviewer.

Important dates:

- 31 July 2011** Notification of attendance and summary of paper (in the language of the paper and in English)
20 September 2011 Submission of papers for publication in the proceedings

Instructions for paper writers:

Papers for publication in the conference proceedings should be of at most 8 pages, including all annexes, literature, résumé and authors addresses, and must be written in MS Word, using Times New Roman font at the font sizes indicated in the example below. All margins should be set at 2.5 cm and you should use single line spacing. All equations and pictures should be centred. The paper can be written in Slovak, Czech or English. The paper (in a computer file with the family name of the author) should be submitted either on CD or by e-mail to the contact address in the invitation. A printed copy should be sent at the same time by post.

Example:

SMITH John, (UK), SMITHOVÁ Anna, (SR) (12 pt, bold, centred)

Summary (11 pt, bold)

A brief (maximum 10 lines of text) summary of the contents in the language of the paper. (11 pt as a single paragraph).

Key words (provide 3 – 5 key words)

Introduction (12 pt, bold)

Start the text (12 pt) with an indentation and set tab stops at 0.5 cm. Each section should be numbered and literature used should be shown at the end.

7 Literature (in the text use standard literature references numbered [1], ...)

1. SMITH, A.: *Title*. Place of publication: Published by, Year, pages 5-15. ISBN no.

Summary (give in English or in Slovak, if the paper is itself in English)

Title of the paper (12 pt, bold, in the language of the summary)
